Turkish Banking Sector Main Indicators (January 2011)

According to the **unconfirmed temporary data*** the banks submitted to our Agency, asset size of the Turkish Banking Sector was TL 1.020.529 as of January 2011. In the last one year period, total assets of the sector increased by TL 202.903 million (24.8%). As of January 2011, within asset items, loans showed a balance by TL 536.610 million while securities showed a balance by TL 285.583 million. When compared to end-2010, loans increased by 2% while securities decreased by 0.8% and NPL (gross) increased by 0.1%. In January 2011, profit of the sector was TL 1.559 million and profit of the period decreased by TL 498 million (24.2%). Capital Adequacy Standard Ratio of the sector which was 20.4% in January 2010 realized as 18.4% as of January 2011.
