Turkish Banking Sector Main Indicators (October 2010)

According to the unascertained temporary data that banks submitted to the database of our Agency*, asset size of Turkish Banking Sector is TL 932.035 million as of October 2010. Asset total of the sector increased by TL 136.480 million (17.2%) in the last one-year period. As of October 2010, within asset items, loans had a balance by TL 482.538 million and securities by TL 273.294 million. Loans and securities increased by 22.9% and 4%, respectively when compared to the end of 2009, while NPLs (gross) decreased by 4.1%. The profit of the sector in October 2010 was TL 18.719 million, profit of the period increased by TL 1.327 million and 7.6% when compared to the previous period. Capital adequacy standard ratio of the sector which was 20.4% in October 2009 is realized as 19.6% as of October 2010.
