As it is known, on March 12, 2021, the Economy Reform Package was shared with the public. Within the scope of “implementation of the credit life cycle project” and “establishment of operational restructuring and firm rehabilitation functions in the banking sector for closely monitored loans” which are among the actions aimed at increasing the asset quality of the banking sector under the aim of strengthening the financial sector in the Package, below mentioned Best Practice Guidelines are added to the official website of our Agency.

- “Guideline on Credit Allocation and Monitoring Processes”, which was prepared to increase the efficiency of the implementations of banks' allocation and monitoring processes and
- “Guideline on Resolution of Non-Performing Receivables” prepared to improve and develop practices regarding the management and mitigation of non-performing receivables in banks' balance sheets.
